## Information on the processing of personal data pursuant to articles 13-14 EU Reg. 2016/679

### Interested parties: Internet website navigators.

TFI CONTROL SRL as Data Controller of your personal data, pursuant to and for the purposes of the EU Reg. 2016/679 hereinafter 'GDPR', hereby informs you that the afore mentioned legislation provides for the protection of data subjects with respect to processing of personal data and that such treatment will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with the legislative provisions of the aforementioned legislation and the confidentiality obligations therein.

Purpose and legal basis of the processing: in particular, your data will be processed for the following purposes related to the implementation of obligations relating to legislative or contractual obligations:

- technical and functional access to the site, no data is kept after closing the browser;
- Advanced navigation purposes or personalized content management;
- Statistical and Analysis purposes of navigation and users.

Your data will also be used for the following purposes related to the execution of measures related to contractual or pre-contractual obligations:

- by means of electronic calculators with the use of software systems managed by third parties;
- by means of electronic calculators with the use of directly managed or programmed software systems;
- temporary treatment in anonymous form

Processing methods. Your personal data may be processed in the following ways:

Each treatment takes place in compliance with the methods referred to in articles 6, 32 of the GDPR and through the adoption of the appropriate security measures provided.

Communication: your data will be communicated exclusively to competent and duly appointed subjects for the performance of the services necessary for the correct management of the relationship, with a guarantee of protection of the rights of the interested party.

Your data will be processed only by personnel expressly authorized by the Data Controller and, in particular, by the following categories of employees:

Your data may be communicated to third parties duly appointed as Data Processors, in particular to:

Disclosure: Your personal data will not be disclosed in any way.

Your personal data may also be transferred, limited to the purposes indicated above, in the following states:

- UE states ;
- United States

Retention period. We inform you that, in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimization, pursuant to art. 5 of the GDPR, the retention period of your personal data is:

- established for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are collected and processed for execution and performance contractual purposes;
- established for a period of time not exceeding the performance of the services provided;
- established for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are collected and processed and in compliance with the mandatory deadlines prescribed by law;

**EU Reg. 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of the interested party**

1. The interested party has the right to obtain :

confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning him, even if not yet registered, and their communication in an intelligible form.

2. The interested party has the right to obtain the indication:

a. to the origin of personal data;

b. the purposes and methods of treatment;

c. the logic applied in case of treatment carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;

d. the identity of the owner, manager and the representative appointed pursuant to article 5, paragraph 2;

e. of the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who can learn about them as appointed representative in the territory of the State, responsible or appointees.

3. The interested party has the right to obtain:

a. to updating, rectification or, when interested, integration of data;

b. the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed;

c. the attestation that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this fulfillment proves impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right;

d. data portability.

4. The interested party has the right to object, in whole or in part:

a. To for legitimate reasons, to the processing of personal data concerning him, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection;

b. to the processing of personal data concerning him for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.
